Section 1. That section 3737.52 of the Revised Code be	6

Sec. 3737.52. (A) As used in this section:	8
(1) "Class B firefighting foam" means a foam that is	9
designed to extinguish a fire caused by flammable liquid.	10
(2) "PFAS chemicals" means a class of fluorinated organic	11
chemicals containing at least one fully fluorinated carbon atom,	12
including perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances, that	13
are designed to be fully functional in class B firefighting foam	14
formulations.	15
(3) "Testing" includes calibration testing, conformance	16
testing, and fixed system testing.	17
(B) Beginning January 1, 2020, no person shall use a class	18
