BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3345.82 of the Revised Code be	6
enacted to read as follows:	
Sec. 3345.82. (A) As used in this section, "electronic	8
communication" means live, audio-enabled communication that	9
permits the trustees attending a meeting, the trustees present	10
in person at the place where the meeting is conducted, and all	
members of the public present in person at the place where the	
meeting is conducted to simultaneously communicate with each	
other during the meeting.	
(B) Notwithstanding division (C) of section 121.22 and	15
sections 3335.06 and 3343.04 of the Revised Code, the board of	16
trustees of a state institution of higher education, as defined	17

in section 3345.011 of the Revised Code, may establish a policy	18
