#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 5.10 and 5.101 of the Revised	4	
Code be amended to read as follows:	5	
Sec. 5.10. All official seals shall have engraved thereon	6	
the coat of arms of the state, as described in section 5.04 of	7	
the Revised Code.	8	
The great seal of the state shall be two and one-half	9	
inches in diameter and shall consist of the coat of arms of the	10	
state within a circle having a diameter of one and three-fourths		
inches, surrounded by the words "THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF		
OHIO" in news gothic capitals. The great seal of the state shall	13	
correspond substantially with the following design:

The design of the great seal shall not be reproduced,	16	
except as required by any provision of the Ohio Constitution and	17	
the Revised Code, unless permission to do so is first obtained		
from the governor. The governor may authorize reproduction of		
the design of the great seal when the purpose is to:	20	
(A) Permit publication of a reproduction of the great seal	21	
of the state of Ohio;		
(B) Aid educational or historical programs;	23	
(C) Promote the economic or cultural development of the	24	
state in a manner deemed appropriate by the governor.	25	
A permanent record shall be kept in the governor's office	26	
of each permit to reproduce the design of the great seal.	27	
No person shall use or permit to be used any reproduction	28
