BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. (A) The Navigator Pilot Program is hereby	7
established to assist public employees in applying for and	8
navigating the federal Public Service Loan Forgiveness Program,	9
20 U.S.C. 1087e(m).	10
(B) Beginning on the effective date of this section and	11
extending until July 1, 2020, the Chancellor of Higher Education	12
shall solicit contracts from outside organizations or	13
individuals who have demonstrated experience with student debt	14
forgiveness to assist in the administration of the Program as	15
determined by the Chancellor. The Chancellor shall negotiate the	16

terms of the contracts so that they are effective from July 1,	17
2020, or as soon thereafter as possible, until June 30, 2021.	18
The contract prices shall be paid with funds appropriated by the	19
General Assembly specifically for that purpose.	20
(C) Beginning on July 1, 2020, the pilot program shall	21
operate in collaboration with a community college, a state	22
university, and a public agency or employer whose employees may	23
qualify for the Public Service Loan Forgiveness Program as	24
selected by the Chancellor.	25
(D) Beginning not later than August 30, 2020, contracted	26
organizations or individuals shall assist the Chancellor and the	27
selected college, university, and public agency or employer with	28
all of the following:	29
(1) Advising public employees on completion of the	30
employment certification form used by the United States	31
Department of Education for the Public Service Loan Forgiveness	32
Program;	33
(2) Disseminating information to public employees	34
regarding any other loan forgiveness programs for which they may	35
