Section 1. (A) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in	5

vocational, or municipal school district, community school	8	
established under Chapter 3314. of the Revised Code, or science,	9	
technology, engineering, or mathematics school established under	10

new five-year projection of operational revenues and	12

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Section 2. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency	18
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public	19
peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is to	20
provide school districts and schools with additional time to	21
address in their five-year fiscal projections the impacts of the	22
closure of schools and financial uncertainty during the period	23
of emergency rising from a COVID-19 outbreak. Therefore, this	24
act shall go into immediate effect.	25
