BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 . That sections 319.27, 321.06, 503.28, and	7
3313.28 be amended and section 117.171 of the Revised Code be	8
enacted to read as follows:	9
Sec. 117.171. (A) Before a county treasurer or fiscal	10
officer leaves office, the county treasurer or fiscal officer	11
shall prepare a certificate of transition, in the form and	12
substance prescribed by the auditor of state, for the successor	13
county treasurer or fiscal officer. For a county auditor, the	14
certificate shall contain an inventory of items delivered in	15
accordance with section 319.27 of the Revised Code and other	16
information prescribed by the auditor of state. For a county	17
treasurer, the certificate shall contain an inventory of items	18
delivered in accordance with section 321.06 of the Revised Code	19

and any other information prescribed by the auditor of state.	20
For a township fiscal officer, the certificate shall contain an	21
inventory of items delivered in accordance with section 503.28	22
of the Revised Code and any other information prescribed by the	23
auditor of state. For a treasurer of a board of education, the	24
certificate shall contain an inventory of items delivered in	25
accordance with section 3313.28 of the Revised Code and any	26
other information prescribed by the auditor of state. For all	27
other fiscal officers, the certificate shall contain an	28
inventory of items, accounts, and any other information	29
prescribed by the auditor of state. The county treasurer or	30
fiscal officer shall sign the certificate. The certificate shall	31
be considered certified by the county treasurer or fiscal	32
officer and the signature of the county treasurer or fiscal	33
officer on the certificate shall have the same effect as though	34
made under oath. The county treasurer or fiscal officer shall	35
retain one copy of the certificate and shall deliver one copy of	36
the certificate to the successor county treasurer or fiscal	37
officer.	38
(B) The auditor of state may test the accuracy of any	39
certificate of transition described in this section and may	40
report discrepancies or findings as described in sections 117.28	41
and 117.29 of the Revised Code.	42
(C) Before prescribing the inventory of items, accounts,	43
and other information to be contained in the certificate of	44
transition, the auditor of state shall solicit input from county	45
treasurers and fiscal officers or from their affiliated groups.	46
(D) As used in this section, "fiscal officer" has the	47
meaning defined in division (D) of section 5705.01 of the	48
Revised Code.	49

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Sec. 319.27. Upon going out of or suspension from office	50
by the board of county commissioners, each county auditor shall	51
deliver to-his the auditor's successor or the appointee of the	52
board, all documents, books, records, vouchers, papers, maps,	53
and other property in his the auditor's hands belonging to the	54
county, and in the case of the death of an auditor, such	55
property shall in like manner be delivered by his the auditor's	56
legal representatives. The county auditor shall include an	57
inventory of the items delivered in accordance with this section	58
in a certificate of transition under section 117.171 of the	59
Revised Code.	60
Sec. 321.06. At the expiration of his the county	61
<u>treasurer's</u> term of office or on— <u>his</u> the treasurer's resignation	62
or removal from office, the—county treasurer shall deliver to	63
his the treasurer's successor all moneys, books, papers, and	64
other property in his the treasurer's possession as treasurer.	65
In case of the death or incapacity of the treasurer, they shall	66
be delivered over by—is the treasurer's legal representatives.	67
The county treasurer shall include an inventory of the items	68
delivered in accordance with this section in a certificate of	69
transition under section 117.171 of the Revised Code.	70
Sec. 503.28. All township officers shall deliver to their	71
successors in office all books, records, documents, laws,	72
obligations, papers, blanks, and all other articles and property	73
belonging to their respective offices or deposited with them in	74
their official capacity. Any person who has been a township	75
officer and refuses to deliver over such property, or any part	76
thereof, shall forfeit not less than five nor more than fifty	77
dollars, to be recovered by action, for the use of the township.	78
The fiscal officer shall include an inventory of the items	79
delivered in accordance with this section in a certificate of	80

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transition under section 117.171 of the Revised Code.	81
Sec. 3313.28. The treasurer of a board of education, at	82
the expiration of the treasurer's term of office, shall deliver	83
to the treasurer's successor all books and papers in the	84
treasurer's hands relating to the affairs of the district,	85
including educator licenses and copies thereof, and reports of	86
school statistics, filed by teachers. The treasurer of a board	87
of education shall include an inventory of the items delivered	88
in accordance with this section in a certificate of transition	89
under section 117.171 of the Revised Code.	90
Section 2. That existing sections 319.27, 321.06, 503.28,	91

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and 3313.28 of the Revised Code are hereby repealed.
