BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3749.01 of the Revised Code be	7

(I) "Special use pool" means a public swimming pool

containing flume slides, wave generating equipment, or other

special features that necessitate different design and safety

requirements. "Special use pool" does not include any water
54
slide or wave generating pool at a public amusement area which

is licensed and inspected by the department of agriculture
56
pursuant to sections 1711.50 to 1711.57 of the Revised Code.

(J) "Public bathing area" means an impounding reservoir, 58basin, lake, pond, creek, river, or other similar natural body 59of water. 60

(K) "Certified swimming class" means an infant swimming61resource (ISR) class; an American red cross swimming class,62swimming lesson, or learn-to-swim class; and any other swimming63class authorized by the director of health.64

(L) "Certified swimming instructor" means a certified ISR instructor; a certified American red cross swimming instructor or swim coach; and any other swim instructor authorized by the director of health.

Section 2. That existing section 3749.01 of the Revised Code is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency 71 measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 72 peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is to 73 continue the essential operation of certified swimming classes. 74 Therefore, this act shall go into immediate effect. 75
