Re: HB 183 (Manchester, Patterson) Allow tax credits to assist beginning farmers

Dear Chairman Koehler,

On behalf of Nationwide, please support passage of HB 183, which proposes to create a tax credit program that would incentivize retiring farmers to sell or rent to beginning farmers in Ohio.
