Senate Bill 40: "Forming Open and Robust University Minds Act"

Hello Madam Chairman and committee members. My name is Sophia Fisher and I'm here on behalf of Young Americans for Liberty. I am a college student attending the University of Akron where I am the President of a club on campus called *Turning Point USA*. As a group, we have had plenty of incidents where our right to free speech has been infringed upon.
