I write, as a citizen of Ohio in **OPPOSITION** to **SENATE BILL 33.**

I oppose Senate Bill 33 because the Constitution of the United States guarantees the citizenry the right to freedom of speech and peaceful assembly regardless of political affiliation. This bill not only restricts those freedoms; it also criminalizes free speech and assembly.

In addition to criminalizing the right of free speech, SB 33 would also criminalize the social justice work carried out by faith-based organizations through peaceful protest. This infringes on religious liberty in favor of promoting the narrow economic self-interest of large corporations.
