My name is Ledy VanKavage and I represent Best Friends Animal Society. There is a national shortage of veterinarians, and this legislation would help more veterinarians remain in Ohio.

HB 67 is important legislation that would encourage veterinarians to provide much needed community services for tuition reimbursement.
