am a resident of Eden Township in Seneca County, Ohio.

I am providing testimony in general support of Sub. HB 6 and very special support of that portion of the bill that allows a referendum by the residents of a township on whether or not wind farms should be constructed in their township.

As background, I am a life-long resident of Seneca County. I decided to return to Ohio and to Seneca County after law school graduation from Wake Forest University. This is not even an Ohio Power Siting Board issue.
