The turbines location will adversely affect our rights.

The wooded area where I live is home to many birds & wildlife. It is also a main migratory path with orioles, Rosebreasted grosbeaks, indigo buntings to name a few. I have seen hundreds & hundreds of Snow Geese this year as well as an increase in BALD Eagles.
