

Here are my comments on the Proposed Bill as far as changes to the Sunshine Laws ORC Section 121.22

Current Law: Two remedies: 1) Writ of Mandamus in the Ohio Supreme Court or Court of Appeals or Court of Common Pleas; 2) Injunctive Relief in the Common Pleas Court

Advantages: An aggrieved person can mitigate his litigation costs by filing a Writ of Mandamus in the Ohio Supreme Court or Court of Appeals and get an immediate decision and immediate relief rather than protracted litigation through Common Pleas and years of appeals; I generally proceed with the fast track and avoidance of the protracted appeal process plus the common pleas court route you get NO Ohio Supreme Court review so bad law at the lower levels could stay

Proposed Law: Court of Claims and Common Pleas Court eliminates the fast track and elimination of avoidance of the protracted years of litigation, aggrieved person has NO OPTION, but slow track and years of appeals
