I oppose SB 317. I have had the privilege of working with children, teens and families my entire career. I spent 15 years providing social work services in a public school setting. Additionally I was a first responder to the Chardon School Shooting, and was placed there for an additional six months to provide trauma based services to students, faculty and administrators. I am a Sandy Hook Promise Leader and have presented safe school assemblies throughout northeast Ohio to hundreds of students and staff. Lastly I worked closely with non for profits that surfaced out of the Virginia Tech shooting including Actively Caring for People. Important to note, I have worked closely with various School Resource Officers whom I hold in high regard.

I cannot even begin to imagine the risks this would place on EVERYONE involved including children, staff, school resource officers, responding police officers, school districts and communities at large.
