Chairman Burke, Vice Chair Huffman, Ranking Member Antonio and Members of the Health, Human Services and Medicaid Committee, thank you allowing me to testify. My name is Donna Shimko and I strongly oppose Senate Bill 23.

ALL women have the legal, moral, basic, human right to **choose** whether or not and when to have a child.

<u>Regardless</u> of your own personal beliefs, I implore you to put yourself into the place of a young Ohio woman who finds herself with an unplanned pregnancy. For any one of a dozen reasons, she <u>cannot</u> have a child <u>at this time in her life</u>.

Envision yourself as that young pregnant woman - you need ALL options available to you: will you have and keep the child? Will you give it up for adoption? OR will you have a SAFE and LEGAL abortion?

You have only discovered that you are pregnant at eight weeks – so if the six-week abortion ban becomes law, the choice of abortion would be denied you. This lack of choice is dangerous – it limits and denies health care options, and gives UNDUE POWER to people who are not involved in a pregnant person's life.

Reproductive rights and reproductive justice must be protected by and for ALL Ohio citizens. Taking away those rights is <u>oppressive</u> and a <u>severe</u> injustice.

I beseech you, to use your empathy, your wisdom, and belief in <u>justice</u> under the law – VOTE AGAINST SB23 – NO SIX-WEEK ABORTION BAN FOR OHIO WOMEN.
