Thank you for allowing me to testify today. My name is Sarah Wagner. I am a medical student in Ohio. I am strongly opposed to SB 23.

As a future healthcare professional, I believe that all patients have a right to autonomy including women who are making decisions about their reproductive health. 90% of women not seeking pregnancy are use contraception. Despite this, up to half of the pregnancies in the United States are unintended. Abortion is a safe and common procedure. The risk of death from an abortion is approximately 14 times higher with childbirth than abortion. This bill will ban abortion at six weeks, a time when many women don't even know they're pregnant, meaning that these women won't even have a chance to make an informed decision about their pregnancy before the decision is made for them.

I ask you to consider my testimony and vote NO on this harmful and dangerous bill.
