related deaths for patients aged less than 30 years, research	28
published in the online medical journal, BMJ Open, indicated	29
that 54 to 76% can be attributed to DKA; and	30
WHEREAS, Persons with type 1 diabetes need insulin	31
constantly to stay alive, either through multiple daily	32
injections or an insulin pump, or they will experience DKA which	33
will result in death; now therefore be it	34
