BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 201.10. All items in the sections of this act	4
numbered in the 200s are hereby appropriated as designated out	5
of any moneys in the state treasury to the credit of the	6
designated fund. For all operating appropriations made in these	7
sections, those in the first column are for fiscal year 2020 and	8
those in the second column are for fiscal year 2021. The	9
operating appropriations made in this act are in addition to any	10
other operating appropriations made for the FY 2020-FY 2021	11
biennium.	12

Of the foregoing appropriation item 600617, Child Care 44 Federal, \$44,800,000 in fiscal year 2021 shall be used to 45 provide grants to child day-care centers and Type A or Type B 46 family day-care homes licensed under Chapter 5104. of the 47 Revised Code. Grant funds shall be used for ongoing 48 infrastructure costs and to help with increased costs to 49 purchase personal protective equipment and for costs or losses 50 relating to smaller class sizes, including previously incurred 51 costs, related to the COVID-19 pandemic. Grants shall be awarded 52 based on a center's or home's capacity to serve children and its 53 rating in the Step Up to Quality program established by section 54 5104.29 of the Revised Code. 55

Of the foregoing appropriation item 600617, Child Care56Federal, \$67,443,557 in fiscal year 2021 shall be used to57provide stipends to certain child care staff and administrators.58These stipends are to be retroactive to October 1, 2020.59Assistant teachers, lead teachers, administrators, lead60administrators, and other verified early childhood professionals61are eligible for \$300 each quarter of fiscal year 2021.62

Section 250.10. Within the limits set forth in this act, 65 the Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts 66 indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation 67 made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in 68 which appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures 69 from operating appropriations contained in the sections of this 70 act numbered in the 200s shall be accounted for as though made 71 in H.B. 166 of the 133rd General Assembly. The operating 72 appropriations made in these sections are subject to all 73 provisions of H.B. 166 of the 133rd General Assembly that are 74 75 generally applicable to such appropriations.

Section 503.10. CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND REAPPROPRIATIONS 76

The Director of Budget and Management shall determine the77amount of the unexpended, unencumbered portion of each78appropriation item appropriated from the Coronavirus Relief Fund79

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(Fund 5CV1) at the end of fiscal year 2021 to be reappropriated	80
for the same purpose in fiscal year 2022. The amounts determined	81
by the Director are hereby reappropriated.	
Section 812.20. Sections 201.10, 205.10, 209.10, 215.10,	83
221.10, 250.10, and 503.10 of this act are exempt from the	84
referendum under Ohio Constitution, Article II, section 1d and	85
therefore take effect immediately when this act becomes law.	86
