BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 201.10. All items in the sections of this act	3
numbered in the 200s are hereby appropriated as designated out	4
of any moneys in the state treasury to the credit of the	5
designated fund. For all operating appropriations made in these	6
sections, those in the first column are for fiscal year 2020 and	7
those in the second column are for fiscal year 2021. The	8
operating appropriations made in this act are in addition to any	9
other operating appropriations made for the FY 2020-FY 2021	10
biennium.	11

BAR AND RESTAURANT ASSISTANCE

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The foregoing appropriation item 195561, Bar and 15 Restaurant Assistance, shall be used by the Development Services 16 Agency to provide grants to bars and restaurants that have been 17 impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Grants shall be awarded in 18 amounts of \$10,000, \$20,000, and \$30,000 and shall be awarded 19 based on factors such as demonstrated loss of revenue and the 20 number of employees eligible bars and restaurants employ. 21

LODGING INDUSTRY GRANTS

The foregoing appropriation item 195562, Lodging Industry23Grants, shall be used by the Development Services Agency to24provide grants for lodging industry businesses impacted by the25COVID-19 pandemic. Grants shall be awarded in amounts of26

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\$10,000, \$20,000, and \$30,000 and shall be awarded based on 27
factors such as a demonstrated loss of revenue and occupancy 28
rates. 29

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CORONAVIRUS RELIEF - SMALL BUSINESS GRANT
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The foregoing appropriation item 195631, Coronavirus31Relief - Small Business Grant, shall be used to provide a \$2,00032grant to any valid liquor permit holder who is authorized to33sell alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption issued34under Chapter 4303. of the Revised Code. Liquor permit holders35who received grants under the Bar and Restaurant Assistance Fund36are eligible to receive grants under this appropriation item.37

Section 250.10. Within the limits set forth in this act, 38 39 the Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation 40 made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in 41 which appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures 42 from operating appropriations contained in the sections of this 43 act numbered in the 200s shall be accounted for as though made 44 in H.B. 166 of the 133rd General Assembly. The operating 45 appropriations made in these sections are subject to all 46 provisions of H.B. 166 of the 133rd General Assembly that are 47 generally applicable to such appropriations. 48

Section 812.10.Sections 201.10, 209.10, and 250.10 of49this act are exempt from the referendum under Ohio Constitution,50Article II, section 1d and therefore take effect immediately51when this act becomes law.52

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
