	contracts for ballot printing, to eliminate the	3
	requirement that all contracts for ballots for	4
	Ohio elections are rewarded to vendors within	5
	the state and printed within the state.	6

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That sections 3505.13 and 3505.14 of the	7
Revised Code be amended to read as follows:	8
Sec. 3505.13. (A) A contract for the printing of ballots	9
involving a cost in excess of twenty-five thousand dollars shall	10
not be let <u>awarded</u>until after five days' <u>a</u> proposal period of	11
fifteen days. During the proposal period, a notice shall be	12
published once in a newspaper of general circulation published	13
in the county-, may be posted electronically by email or other	14
<u>electronic means by the board of elections, or upon notice and </u>	15
may be given by mail by the board of elections, addressed to the	16
responsible printing offices within the state.	17

Except (B) Except as otherwise provided in this section, 18

each bid proposal for such printing <u>a</u> contract described in	19	
division (A) of this section must be accompanied by a bid bond		
with at least two sureties, or a surety company, satisfactory to	21	
the board, in a sum double of ten per cent of the amount of the	22	
bid, conditioned upon the faithful performance of the contract-		
for such printing as is awarded and for the payment as damages	24	
by such bidder to the board of any excess of cost over the bid	25	
which it may be obliged to pay for such work by reason of the	26	
failure of the bidder to complete the contractproposal. No bid-	27	
proposal unaccompanied by such <u>bid bond</u> shall be considered by	28	
the board. The board may, however, waive the requirement that	29	
each bid be accompanied by a bond if the cost of the contract is	30	
twenty-five thousand dollars or less.	31	
The (C) The contract shall be let <u>awarded</u> to the lowest	32	
<u>most qualified</u> responsible bidder in the state. All ballots	33	
shall be printed within the state proposer that meets the minimum	34	
standards established by the secretary of state under division_	35	
(D) of this section. The proposer shall post a performance bond	36	
equal to one hundred per cent of a single election's contract	37	
amount. If the contract is for multiple elections, then the	38	
board instead may require the proposer to post a performance	39	
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bond of a sum equal to one hundred per cent of the board's		
estimated ballot printing costs for the largest election to be	41	
conducted during the contract period.	42	
(D) The secretary of state shall adopt rules establishing	43	
printing, mailing, and security standards for vendors that print	44	
ballots under contracts entered into under this section, in		
accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code.	46	
Sec. 3505.14. After the letting awarding of the contract	47	
for the printing of the ballots as provided in section 3505.13	48	

of the Revised Code, the board of elections shall secure from	49
the printer printed proofs of the ballot, and shall notify the	50
chairman chairperson of the local executive committee of each	51
party or group represented on the ballot by candidates or	52
issues, and post such proofs in a public place in the office of	53
the board for a period of at least twenty-four hours for	54
inspection and correction of any errors appearing thereon. The	55
board shall cause such proofs to be read with care and after	56
correcting any errors shall return the corrected copy to the	57
printer.	58
Section 2. That existing sections 3505.13 and 3505.14 of	59
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the Revised Code are hereby repealed.	

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
