BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. (A) The Chancellor of Higher Education, in	3	
collaboration with the Ohio State University Cooperative	4	
Extension Services and Central State University Cooperative	5	
Extension Services, shall establish the Urban Farmer Youth	6	
Initiative Pilot Program to provide relevant programming and	7	
support with regard to farming and agriculture to young people	8	
between the ages of six to eighteen living in urban areas.	9	
(B) The pilot program shall operate for fiscal years 2022	10	
and 2023 and offer programming in at least two, but not more	11	
than four, counties.		
(C)(1) The Chancellor and the Ohio State University	13	
Cooperative Extension Services and Central State University	14	
Cooperative Extension Services may do both of the following:	15	
(a) Use up to fifteen per cent of the amount appropriated	16	
for fiscal year 2022 for the pilot program to develop and	17	

establish the pilot program;

(b) Partner with local entities to deliver programming for	19
the pilot program. The Chancellor and the extension services may	20
pay entities for services with funds appropriated for this	21

(2) Any appropriated funds may also be used to support	23
existing agricultural organizations to help expand programming	
to include young people living in urban areas.	25
Section 2. All items in this act are hereby appropriated	26
as designated out of any moneys in the state treasury to the	27
credit of the designated fund. For all operating appropriations	28
made in this act, those in the first column are for fiscal year	29
2022 and those in the second column are for fiscal year 2023.	30

The operating appropriations made in this act are in addition to 31 any other operating appropriations made for the FY 2022-FY 2023 32 biennium. 33
