## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

(a) The bill statement related to the debt is sent by the United States postal service during the covered period.
(b) The bill statement is not delivered to the consumer within seven days after the date stated on a bill statement sent by a creditor or debt collector to the consumer.
(2) The creditor or debt collector shall assume a delay in United States postal service is the cause of a late payment by a consumer, if the bill statement for the payment of the debt was sent to the consumer by the United States postal service during the covered period.
(C) Any attempt by a creditor or a debt collector to charge a consumer a late fee, fine, or penalty related to a debt is void if both of the following apply:
(1) The bill statement related to the debt was sent by the United States postal service during the covered period.
(2) The bill statement is not delivered to the consumer within seven days after the date stated on a bill statement sent by a creditor or debt collector to the consumer.

Section 2. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is to provide temporary relief to consumers negatively impacted from
