## A BILL

To prohibit creditors from charging late fees that	1
result from United States postal service delays	2
and to declare an emergency.	3

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. (A) As used in this section:	4
(1) "Consumer" means any individual who resides in this	5
state and who receives or expects to receive via the United	6
States postal service a bill statement for a debt owed.	7
(2) "Covered period" means the period beginning on the	8
effective date of this section and ending thirty days after the	9
end of the period of emergency declared by Executive Order 2020-	10
01D, issued on March 9, 2020.	11
(3) "Creditor" means any person to whom a debt is owed or	12
other obligation for payment.	13
(4) "Debt collector" means a creditor, and any person or	14
entity that engages in the collection of debt, including the	15
state or local government or any agency thereof, irrespective of	16
whether the debt is allegedly owed to or assigned to that person	17

or to the entity.	18
(B)(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the	19
contrary, no creditor or debt collector shall, during the	20
covered period, charge a consumer a late fee, fine, or penalty	21
relating to a late payment on a debt owed by the consumer when	22
both of the following apply:	23
(a) The bill statement related to the debt is sent by the	24
United States postal service during the covered period.	25
(b) The bill statement is not delivered to the consumer	26
within seven days after the date stated on a bill statement sent	27
by a creditor or debt collector to the consumer.	28
(2) The creditor or debt collector shall assume a delay in	29
United States postal service is the cause of a late payment by a	30
consumer, if the bill statement for the payment of the debt was	31
sent to the consumer by the United States postal service during	32
the covered period.	33
(C) Any attempt by a creditor or a debt collector to	34
charge a consumer a late fee, fine, or penalty related to a debt	35
is void if both of the following apply:	36

(1) The bill statement related to the debt was sent by the37United States postal service during the covered period.38

(2) The bill statement is not delivered to the consumer

within seven days after the date stated on a bill statement sent

by a creditor or debt collector to the consumer.

Section 2. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency42measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public43peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is to44provide temporary relief to consumers negatively impacted from45
