BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 5163.06 be amended and section	6
5163.062 of the Revised Code be enacted to read as follows:	7

By requiring the medicaid program to provide coverage to	48
the optional eligibility group consisting of employed	49
individuals with disabilities under division (C) of section	50
5163.06 of the Revised Code, it is the intent of the general	51
assembly to establish medicaid coverage for employed individuals	52
with disabilities who are sixty-five years of age or older in a	53
manner that is consistent with the coverage provided to	54
individuals participating in the medicaid buy-in for workers	55
with disabilities program described in sections 5163.09 to	56
5163.098 of the Revised Code.	57
Section 2. That existing section 5163.06 of the Revised	58
Code is hereby repealed.	59
Section 3. Upon approval of a state plan amendment by the	60
United States Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services	61
authorizing Medicaid coverage for the optional eligibility group	62
specified in section 1902(a)(10)(A)(ii)(XIII) of the "Social	63
Security Act," 42 U.S.C. 1396a(a)(10)(A)(ii)(XIII) and	64
authorized under sections 5163.06 and 5163.062 of the Revised	65
Code, the Medicaid Director may certify to the Director of	66
Budget and Management the necessary amount to pay for the	67
optional eligibility group described in this act in fiscal year	68
2022 and fiscal year 2023. Upon certification, the necessary	69
amounts, both state and federal shares, are hereby appropriated	70
to appropriation item 651525, Medicaid Health Care Services.	71
Section 4. Within the limits set forth in this act, the	72
Director of Budget and Management shall establish accounts	73
indicating the source and amount of funds for each appropriation	
made in this act, and shall determine the form and manner in	75
which appropriation accounts shall be maintained. Expenditures	76
