# **Vote NO on HB 508**

## Protect the Best Interests of Children

April 4, 2022

Dear legislator -

Please join more than 80 legal, child and family-focused organizations across Ohio and oppose HB 508. (See page 2 for a complete list).

Child safety should be the first priority of custody adjudications. But HB 508, also known as the "equal-parenting" bill, shifts Ohio's current child-centric model to a parent-entitlement model. Equal parenting-presumption legislation takes necessary discretion away from courts and will result in outcomes that are harmful to children and survivors of domestic violence.

Current law requires judges to focuses on the "best interests" of the child. H.B. 508 mandates equal parenting responsibilities and equal parenting time unless there is clear and convincing evidence that it would be detrimental to the child. While the bill maintains the best interest factors, a court cannot even consider them until clear and convincing evidence of detriment to the child is proven. The Ohio Judicial Conference says this "double hurdle" would be insurmountable in most domestic violence or child abuse cases.

The vast majority of custody arrangements are settled out of court. The small percentage that must be adjudicated typically involve complex problems, including abuse. Research shows that about 90% of custody cases are resolved without significant court intervention (mediation, custody evaluations, litigation).<sup>1,2</sup> Among the 10% of cases that are litigated, **approximately 75% involve reports of domestic violence.**<sup>3</sup>

HB 508 would increase litigation because that is the only way victims can challenge the equal-parenting-time presumption. HB 508 would be especially harmful for low-income victims who often will not have the funds to challenge an equal-time mandate. Litigation abuse is a common tactic used by abusers because it is one of the few remaining ways they can control their victims after the family separates.

These costs and the extreme stress of fighting an abuser in court undermine the well being of parents and children. Oppose HB 508 and preserve judges' discretion on a case-by-case basis to consider the best interest of children in custody cases.
