On behalf of the Distilled Spirits Council of the United (DISCUS), a national trade association representing some of the world's leading distillers both large and small we respectfully request your support of HB 46, legislation that would provide much needed assistance to the many hospitality industry businesses that have been impacted by COVID-19. During these unprecedented times, you have listened to the plight of Ohio's restaurants and bars as they struggled to cope with the challenges posed by COVID-19. As one of the first to allow cocktails to-go, on a permanent basis you have been a real champion for Ohio's hospitality industry, and we ask that you continue to be loud voice by supporting HB 46.

Thousands of hospitality businesses across Ohio including restaurants, taverns, bars, distilleries, and their retail sales operations and tasting rooms have been closed either completely or in some capacity since mid-March. According to the National Restaurant Association, sales at restaurants were down 78 percent in the first few weeks of the nationwide lockdown, causing restaurants to lay off 86 percent of their employees. Clearly, this has had a devastating impact on the thousands of people employed by on-premises establishments in Ohio.

Ohio's restaurants, bars and distilleries have been absolutely devastated by the COVID-19 pandemic, and HB 46 will help ease the burden of some of their administrative costs. Specifically, hospitality businesses will be able to use the money saved from license renewals to reinvest and recover. Ohio restaurants, bars and distilleries are in desperate need of relief, and this bill is a great place to start. Thank you in advance for your support and thank you for introducing this much needed legislation.
