Chairman Stein, Vice Chair Johnson, Ranking Member Lepore-Hagan and members of the House Commerce and Labor Committee. Please accept this proponent testimony for HB 88.

My name is Dave McElfresh, I am a fulltime firefighter and paramedic and a legislative committee representative for the OAPFF. The Ohio Association of Professional Fire Fighters represents over 12,000 fulltime fire, rescue, and EMS providers in over 270 jurisdictions across Ohio.

HB 88 expands the jurisdiction of the Ohio Construction Industry Licensing Board to license commercial roofers. The OAPFF supports this expansion, and we ask for the committee to favorably report HB 88.

As building construction techniques and materials continue to evolve, including lightweight trusses, synthetics, insulation products, vapor barriers and fire rated components it is imperative that the buildings our citizens live work and recreate in are as safe as possible.

We believe that the complexity of commercial roof structures and the associated fire protection systems require contractors to keep up with best practices and current methods. HB 88 provides a commonsense approach to improve public safety by doing just that.
