Under HB 22 you can pick up a felony charge just by distracting a police officer during peaceful public witness. Obstruction of justice is defined so broadly under the law that it can be applied to someone for merely throwing confetti or flowers. Over the past year Ohioans have already been brutalized by police during peaceful protest events. Any laws pertaining to protest should protect US, the American people, instead of penalize our First Amendment actions. Do NOT let SB 22 pass!
