First, I do not think guns in a school are a good idea because it is possible a student or angry parent could disarm a teacher or staff person and shoot them.

Second, 8 hours of training is totally inadequate. Why bother with any training? You might as well make it ZERO training.

Third, I have known classroom teachers and staff members to be pushed beyond the point of rationality and physically assault students. What would have happened if they had been armed with a gun?

Fourth, We know of many incidents of students carrying weapons of various types into schools. What message are we sending to students by allowing school employees to bring those weapons to school?

This legislation is trying to solve a problem where none exists. It's ridiculous.
