Up until the recent court decision, our highly skilled Armed Response Team members could react to this horrific situation and eliminate the armed intruder, minimizing lost or injured lives. I say skilled members because our school district has mandated, through our policies, that each Armed Response Team member actively participate in numerous hours of training, weapon qualifications, simulations, and practice range time provided and directed by our local Sheriff's department each year.
