## House Families, Aging, and Human Services Committee Paul Pfeifer Interested Party Testimony on House Bill 83 April 15, 2021

Chair Manchester, Vice Chair Cutrona, Ranking Member Liston, and members of the House Families, Aging, and Human Services Committee, I thank you for this opportunity to submit interested party testimony for House Bill 83 on behalf of the Ohio Judicial Conference. I am Paul Pfeifer, Executive Director of the Judicial Conference.

The OJC's Domestic Relations and Juvenile Law & Procedure Committees have reviewed and discussed H.B. 83 and its prior versions on numerous occasions over the last two years. We support the bill's intent of efficiently redirecting child support payments to a child's caretaker for the benefit of the child. We believe this bill has been well-vetted thanks to the sponsor's interested party process during the 133rd General Assembly. We have no concerns with the bill as currently written.
