

RELIEF FUNDS NEEDED

Assisted Living providers were asked to do a lot with very little support.

Providers were asked to **care-in-place** during this pandemic which as a result has increased costs significantly. Additional costs incurred by COVID-19 cannot be passed on to seniors on fixed incomes without transitioning them quickly to Medicaid and nursing home care.

Genworth Survey showing National Median Cost of Care

% Change Since 2019 in Cost of Care

Assisted Living	6.15%
Nursing Home - private room	3.57%
Home Health	4.35%
Adult Daycare	-1.33%

Contributing to rate increases: wage pressures, employee recruitment & retention challenges, regulatory changes (including updated CDC guidelines), PPE costs, Labor shortages, supply & demand.
