I am a working engineering management professional, husband, father of 4 and a USMC vet.

I currently have an Ohio CCW license, as I am fortunate to have the financial means to cover the fees involved to meet current requirements in place today by Ohio law. The current law discriminates against citizens of lesser means, by placing a financial hardship on citizens to pay absorbent fees for training and licensing required to gain an Ohio CCW.
