Chairman Burke, Vice Chairman Huffman, Ranking Member Antonio and all members of the Senate Health, Human Services, and Medicaid Committee, my name is James Yep and I am the coowner, along with my brother, of a second generation family business in Illinois; TRIUNE Health Group.
