Chairman Lipps, Vice Chair Holmes, Ranking Member Russo, and Members of the House Health Committee, thank you for the opportunity to provide proponent testimony on House Bill 248.

My name is Jason C. Horsman and I am a Software Engineer. I support House Bill 248 because Ohioans need protection for their freedom to make health care decisions for themselves, free from fear of discrimination from businesses and employers. Two of my friends have felt so much pressure from their jobs that they've gotten vaccinated simply because they feared that they would lose their jobs if they didn't. It's easy to see how this pressure will work already just in the CDC's masking policies that are now forcing people who are not vaccinated to continue wearing masks in stores, in workplaces, and in restaurants. That is an invasion of a person's privacy as it makes it very easy to tell who has chosen to be vaccinated and who hasn't.
