Chairman Lipps, Vice Chair Holmes, Ranking Member Russo, and Members of the House Health Committee, thank you for the opportunity to provide proponent testimony on House Bill 248.

My name is Elizabeth and I am a middle school teacher turned stay at home mom and the reason I support House Bill 248 is because I believe everyone in Ohio deserves medical freedom. I believe in religious exemptions as well as medical exemptions. I believe in informed consent and the option to decline vaccines. I believe Ohioans who choose to vaccinate or wear masks should do so willingly, not under threat or bribery. I also believe those who decide not to vaccinate or cover their faces should not be penalized or discriminated against. Over the last 14 months we've learned a lot about Covid-19 and the death rate is incredibly low, especially in children. We do not need to make this vaccine mandatory!
