Chairman Lipps, Vice Chair Holmes, Ranking Member Russo, and Members of the House Health Committee, thank you for the opportunity to provide proponent testimony on House Bill 248.

I am a resident of Anderson Twp., in Cincinnati. My name is Nancy Fuller. I am a native of Cincinnati and I have raised my 3 grown sons here. I had a career in Management for 24 years at a multi-billion dollar packaging manufacturer. I am currently semi-retired.
