Thank you for the opportunity to provide proponent testimony on House Bill 248.

My name is Sarah Hardesty. I am a stay at home mom to six homeschooled children and a lifelong resident of Ohio. I support House Bill 248 because I support all people being able to freely make health decisions without manipulation, coercion, or intimidation. This liberty has already been established in the Ohio Constitution and the Nuremberg Code, but the enactments of mask mandates over the past year and a half have shown how quickly those liberties can be taken away by governors, employers, and businesses. My husband is a Tax Auditor and has been required to wear a mask at work even though he has given medical and religious reasons why he should be exempt. His employer has not been willing to offer any exemptions or accommodations, and I fear that this could happen with vaccines, which is why we need House Bill 248 passed!
