My name is Susan Kohl, as a US citizen, parent and pediatric physical therapist I <u>support</u> House Bill 248.

1. Citizens, patients, and employees should have the <u>freedom to choose</u> to vaccinate or not vaccinate without discrimination, especially when the vaccine (COVID), is still on experimental, non-FDA approved medical status with the following:
