Chairman Lipps, Vice Chair Holmes, Ranking Member Russo, and Members of the House Health Committee, thank you for the opportunity to provide proponent testimony on House Bill 248.

My name is Kathleen Milchak and I am a stay at home mom. I support HB 248 because the issues of health care freedom, bodily autonomy, healthcare privacy, and protection from discrimination regarding personal health care choices are the most important issues to myself and my family, surpassing all others. Without these rights, we are no longer a free people.
