Chairman Lipps, Vice Chair Holmes, Ranking Member Russo, and Members of the House Health Committee, thank you for the opportunity to provide proponent testimony on House Bill 248.

My name is Mary C Schmiesing and I am a mother and grandmother who has been blessed with many children and grandchildren all of whom live here in Ohio. The reason I support House Bill 248 is because I believe our right to make medical & health care decisions is inalienable. I don't believe the government has the right or the wisdom to decide whether or not we use certain medical products or how/ when we use them.
