Dear Chairman Lipps, Vice Chair Holmes, Ranking Member Russo, and Members of the House Health Committee, thank you for the opportunity to provide proponent testimony on House Bill 248.

My name is Susie Snyder and I am a stay at home mom and the reason I support House Bill 248 is because I have two vaccine injured children.

My oldest suffered seizures after his 12 month vaccinations. These seizures led to a learning disability diagnosis. I was told that the seizures were not related to his vaccines and made to feel like a bad parent.

Believing that my oldest son's injuries were not vaccine related, I vaccinated my youngest. My youngest suffered the same fate at this 12 month vaccinations, except he suffered autoimmune encephalitis, which resulted in an autism diagnosis a few months later.

He will require full time care for the rest of his life.

No child should have to go through what my children have gone through. All parents should get to choose what medical interventions they want for their children.

Neither of my sons can get this vaccine, if it is mandated. It would likely lead to their deaths.

Please vote yes on this bill and pass HB 248. There is no reason not to. This still gives those who want to get the vaccine the choice; while allowing those that do not want to a choice as well.
