Chairman Lipps, Vice Chair Holmes, Ranking Member Russo, and Members of the House Health Committee, thank you for the opportunity to provide proponent testimony on House Bill 248.

My name is Karen Wirtz, I'm a mother, veteran, and small business owner.

I support House Bill 248 because it is important to protect the rights of Ohioans to decide for themselves whether or not they want to get the experimental Covid-19 vaccine or any vaccine. Before you label me anti-vax straight away, I would like to point out that to this point I am fully vaccinated. Additionally, I am a veteran and my husband is a retiree. My husband received an experimental vaccine - the Anthrax vaccine - and he now suffers from an auto-immune disorder because of that. People should never be forced to take a vaccine, especially an experimental one. Americans like us and many other veterans we know who suffered as a result of the experimental anthrax vaccine are cautious. We do not wish to be guinea pigs again.
