HB 248: To Prohibit Required Vaccination Status Opponent Testimony: [NAME] Ohio House Health Committee June 22, 2021

Chairman Lipps, Vice-Chair Holmes, Ranking Member Russo and Members of the House Health Committee,

My name is Gregory King and I write in opposition to HB 248. If HB248 passes it has the potential to be deadly for Ohio citizens and devastating for our economy.

It would almost certainly cause a resurgence of deadly diseases previously controlled for decades by vaccines, including polio, measles, meningitis, HPV, mumps, and rubella. We do not even think about these diseases any more because vaccines have been so successful. This bill puts Ohioans at unnecessary risk.
