Chairman Lipps, Vice-Chair Holmes, Ranking Member Russo, and Members of the House Health Committee, thank you for the opportunity to provide proponent testimony on House Bill 248.

My name is Anita Williams, and I am a retired office manager and former Ohio Notary Public. For 19 years, I worked for Dr. Nick Koinoglou, a Chiropractor in Alliance, Ohio. During my years of employment, I learned much about how the alignment of our spine affects our physical health. Hippocrates said, "Look well to the spine for the cause of disease." Dr. Koinoglou is a great doctor and a good teacher. He taught me proper spinal alignment not only retards disease processes in our bodies but also boosts our immune system.

Before my employment, where I was able to receive regular chiropractic care, I suffered from debilitating migraine headaches and was very susceptible to ear and sinus infections, colds, and flu. However, I am 68 years old now. I am healthy. I take no prescription medications, keep myself active, and continue receiving chiropractic care when needed. I believe strongly in natural health care because God designed our bodies to heal and to be able to fight off infections and viruses, given the proper care and nutrition. Natural immunity is always best.

There are many reasons I support House Bill 248, but I'll name three:

First, I believe every person should have the **right to choose** whether or not they will put a virtually untested foreign substance into their body. And if they decline, they should not be discriminated against by being forced to divulge private medical information, carry a Naziesque identification card, or wear a mask.

Second, I do not believe a vaccine is necessary when there is long-tested medication that will cure the COVID-19 virus and save lives, especially when there is a 99.5 survival rate without any medication at all. For a year now, the Frontline Doctors, Dr. Simone Gold, Dr. Stella Immanuel, and others have been using Hydroxychloroquine with Zinc and Vitamins D and C, and also Ivermectin to treat patients with COVID-19. These doctors have had incredible success—even with those who have several comorbidities.
