Chairman Lipps, Vice Chair Holmes, Ranking Member Russo, and Members of the House Health Committee, thank you for the opportunity to provide proponent testimony on House Bill 248.

My name is April Lewis and I am a wife and mother of three young children. The reason I support House Bill 248 is because I am committed to protecting my right to make medical decisions for myself and my family.

The Citizens of Ohio have been subjected to many unlawful mandates, lockdowns and closures. Now we are seeing private companies mandating experimental vaccines to their employees.

My husband is an analyst with a home office. His employer notified him two weeks ago that he will be terminated if he does not take the experimental covid 19 shot, which he neither needs nor wants. Their "justification?" Because the CDC says so. The CDC is not elected. They do not make law.
