Chairman Lipps, Vice Chair Holmes, Ranking member Russo, and members of the house health committee, I appreciate the opportunity to provide proponent testimony for House Bill 248.

My name is Ben Dyer and I am from Cincinnati Ohio. I am an estate manager, and my wife is a local hero at one of the tri-states largest hospital employers, Tri-Health. As active participants in our community, and society, it is vitally important to us that House Bill 248 be passed, as it is now, immediately.

My wife and I contracted covid naturally back in February, of 2021 right before the birth of our newborn baby girl. My wife and I both had very mild symptoms and recovered quickly with no issues. Since then, we have been pressured to take a vaccine for a viral infection that our bodies have already beaten. There are multiple studies that have concluded that the best defense for covid 19 is a natural infection, followed by the body's natural response (Cleveland Clinic). We have had nothing but bad experiences from those in our family who have had the vaccination, and due to the lack of transparency from the CDC, the media, and other compromised outlets, we do not have faith that the information being provided is accurate or honest.
