Dear Chairman Lipps, Vice Chair Holmes, Ranking Member Russo, and Members of the House Health Committee, thank you for the opportunity to provide proponent testimony on House Bill 248. My name is Chloe Evans, I am a hospital patient care technician/senior nursing student, and I am in support of House Bill 248 for a variety of reasons. Primarily, as a young and healthy twenty-year-old female the mandate of a vaccine that has been on the market for less than a year and has unknown long-term effects is unnerving. Although there is insistence from "independent research companies" that the Covid vaccines are safe, no long-term data is available; therefore, the possibility of unforeseen side effects of the vaccine ten years in the future are a real possibility.
