Chairman Lipps, Vice Chair Holmes, Ranking Member Russo, and Members of the House Health Committee, thank you for the opportunity to provide proponent testimony on House Bill 248.

My name is Christy Jaynes and I am a stay-at-home mother of 4 and wife to an Ohio teacher of 18 years. We are also parents to a vaccine injured child, which is why I had to resign from my career of 15 years to stay home and care for our son.
